## What You Need To Know

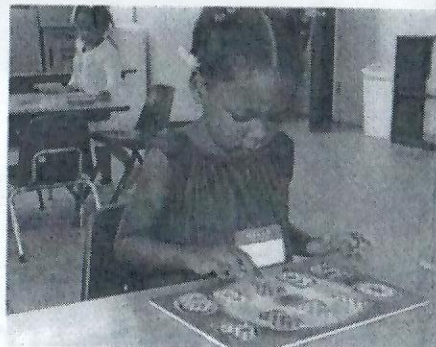
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The K3 Program began in September 2010 as part of the expansion and development plan of Kingsway Academy. We look forward to getting to know you and to training your child in the King's way spiritually, academically, socially, emotionally, physically and mentally. We pledge to provide learning experiences that will lend to a solid and positively memorable foundation for success in the years ahead.

You can expect students to engage in age-appropriate activities and learning experiences that will build their self-esteem and confidence, and remind them that they are specially created by God. Each week these lessons and play sessions will be based on specific themes.

Students will participate in the following: King's Court (morning assembly), Devotions and Bible, Language Development and Literacy Training, Arithmetic and Reasoning Skills, Social Studies, Fine Arts (inclusive of visual, music and drama), Physical Education (games and sports, gross and fine motor skills), Music and Spanish. These activities will take place through exploration at Learning Centers, participation in Circle Time, Small and Whole Groups and during Story Times. While some sessions are structured and guided, some time will be allowed for students to make their own discoveries.



## SCHOOL HOURS

Students will be permitted into the classrooms at 7:45 am with classes officially beginning at 8:30 am and ending at 2:30 pm. Any child remaining after 3:15 pm will be admitted to the Kingdom Care Program. Payment for this service is \$10 per hour per day and is due upon arrival or may be paid in advance.

## RECESS & LUNCH BREAKS

Students will have morning and afternoon recess, as well as a lunch break. Meals will be eaten inside the classroom. Parents should send healthy snacks for recess and a heartier meal for lunch. The school's lunch menu will be posted and items may be purchased through the teacher. We believe that school is a great place to shape healthy lifestyle, and request that parents refrain from sending "junk foods" or "fast foods". Small bottles of water should be sent daily and an extra drink on PE days.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURES

- Students must be 3 years old by 31 October
- Completed Application & Supplement forms (with birth certificate, passport, immunization card, p/p sized photo)
- National Insurance Number
- Signed Parent Agreement Form
- \$30 application fee
- Observation / Evaluation Session
- Interview with School Administrator
- \$150 Seat & Enrollment Fee (upon approval) non-refundable
- Medical Insurance
- Health Form (must be completed before start of school)

## TUITION & FEES

Fees for the 2017-2018 academic year are as follows:

Tuition	\$875.00 per term (3 terms per year)
Books/Supplies	\$95.00 per year (approximately)
Seat Fee	\$50.00 per year (billed in Term 2)

Uniforms & PE outfits vary in prices according to size needs.

Parents also accept the cost of field trips and other special events during the year.

**Please note:** All students remaining at Kingsway Academy for K4 will be required to pay the one-time Development Fee of \$600.

All fees are subject to change. Updates will be provided by the school's office.
